**Grand Champion (in open halter) :** receives 2 additional points. Example 6G would mean 8 pts  
**Reserve Champion:** receives 1 additional point, i.e. 6R would be 7 pts

**Note:** For horses showing in a class but not placing, give a "0" to show that they were in the class but received no points. (This will be important at year-end when determining who showed 60%)

For *class awards* exhibitors must show to 60% of the judges. For 2000 that will be 9 judges.  
 In case of ties, use Judge A on the first show following July 1<sup>st</sup>.

For *year-end division awards*, the exhibitor must show to 60% of open halter for open horse and the YA and AM divisions must show 60% of their showmanship class. The horse and rider are teams in YA and AM for points. For example if I show Derby in showmanship in May then it's a Derby/Glenda combination but if I show Cinnamon in June then we start a second different set of points for Cinnamon/Glenda.
