

## **JNPtHA Meeting**

**Date: June 24, 2011**

Location: Laudenklos Memorial Show (Lancaster Event Center)

Members Present: Selena Finn, Elizabeth Blaser, Jocelyn Behlen, Bo Behlen, Cissy Yeager, Emily Critser, Callie Finn and Karlie Miller. JNPtHA Youth Advisor Julie Kyriss and Amy Blaser were also present.

President Selena Finn called the meeting to order at 8:00PM.

The Roll Call of Officers was taken by Elizabeth Blaser. Officers present included Selena Finn (President), Karlie Miller (Vice President), Elizabeth Blaser (Secretary) and Jocelyn Behlen (Treasurer). Officers absent included Brittany Dake (Historian).

Meeting minutes were available from June 3, 2011 and Elizabeth Blaser distributed the minutes for all in attendance to review. The minutes were reviewed and approved with no changes.

Jocelyn Behlen reported the Youth Show made a profit of \$932.32. Emily motioned, Karlie Miller seconded the motion to approve the Treasurer's report. The general membership voted in favor of the motion.

### OLD BUSINESS

- Youth Sponsored Show June 4th. Julie and Amy thanked all of the Youth for their work doing what was needed and especially opening/closing gates.
- Costume Class. Elizabeth brought printed color copies of the flyers for the Costume Class to distribute at local barns, TSC stores, tape on rest room stalls and to set out at the Registration table at the Laudenklos show. Emily Critser motioned, Karlie Miller seconded that the Costume Class is open to all breeds. The general membership voted in favor of the motion. Also, the Costume Class will be held Saturday, September 10<sup>th</sup> at Christensen Fields in Fremont, NE right before the afternoon fun games. After discussion, it was agreed that Youth Club members would ask for three judges; Emily agreed to ask either Holly or Terry Schultz, Kylie Miler will ask Karlie Miller, and Cissy will talk with Myron Andrews. Once confirmed, please let Julie or Amy know if these people are available and agree to judge.

### NEW BUSINESS

- As a fundraiser for the Youth Club, it was discussed and agreed upon that we will design and sell NE Pinto Club t-shirts this year. All youth were encouraged to bring designs to consider. Elizabeth Blaser brought four designs for consideration, in addition to two color shirt samples; sapphire blue and lime green. The blue would have white lettering, the green would have black lettering. It was discussed that we should offer short sleeved, long sleeved and a hoodie option. The youth voted on one design; the logo will be on the front right pocket area with the state of NE and a horse graphic on the back. Optional to add your name or horse's name and/or

exhibitor number to the shirt / hoodie at an additional cost. Elizabeth and Amy will work to finalize order form and samples for distribution and promotion at the July 23<sup>rd</sup> show in Fremont. We will also promote the sales through email and via the club's Facebook account as well. It was agreed upon that we will set the cost at a \$2 profit per sale which will go to the Youth Club treasury.

- Various Youth Club members requested consideration of a different Youth Club meeting time as 8PM gets late for those that don't stay on site and have to drive home and then return again in the morning to show the next day. Options for meeting start time were discussed at 6PM or 7PM. After discussion, it was motioned by Karlie Miller, seconded by Cissy Yeager to move the Youth Club Meeting start time back from 8PM to 7PM beginning at the next show. The motion was voted on and approved by general membership. If this time turns out to now work for the members, we can always bring it back up for discussion as during the school year, it may be more difficult to start at 7PM vs. 8PM.
- Elizabeth Blaser recognized and the club members applauded Selena Finn on her recent achievement of World Champion Reiner. Selena just got back from the World Show in Tulsa, OK.
